The UK's National Centre for the 3Rs (NC3Rs) works nationally and internationally to advance the 3Rs by funding research and early career development, providing training and resources to put the 3Rs into practice, supporting open innovation and the commercialisation of 3Rs technologies, and stimulating changes in policy, regulations and practice. The NC3Rs website hosts a comprehensive online 3Rs resource library containing guidance, webinars, e-learning and practical tools for researchers, technicians and vets, members of ethical review bodies, research funders and regulators. Topics cover *in vivo* techniques and animal welfare, research culture and ethical review, experimental design and reporting, alongside replacement technologies and new approach methodologies (NAMs). The portfolio area of the site provides details of past and ongoing 3Rs projects, including those supported by NC3Rs funding alongside programmes of work undertaken by our in-house scientific teams. Our Networks bring together researchers to maximise the impact of 3Rs innovations in key scientific area, currently open in Cardiovascular science, Oncology and NAMs. We also host dedicated websites for our Experimental Design Assistant (EDA) online tool and the ARRIVE guidelines.
