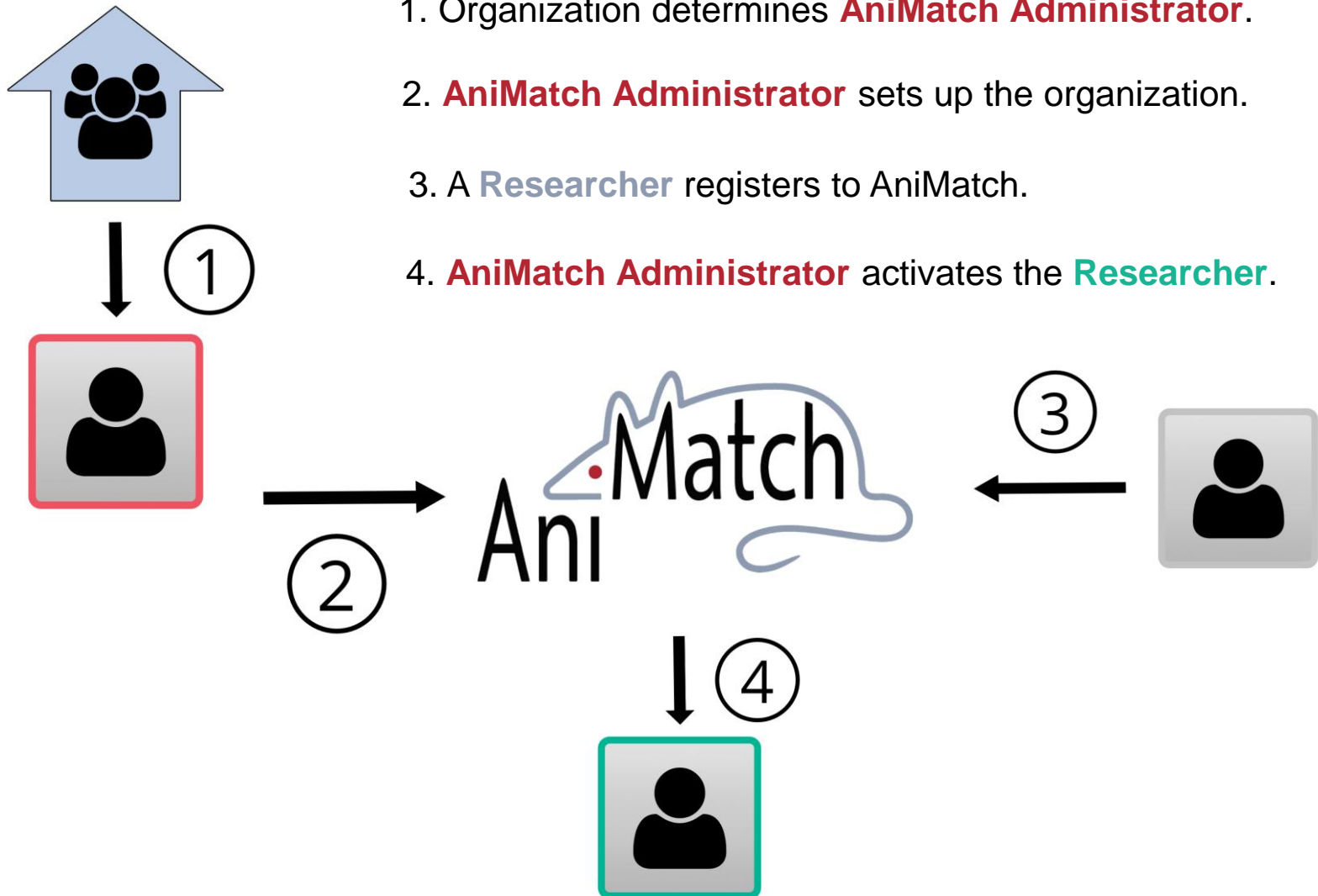




- Open for **interested institutions** (Academic and non-academic)

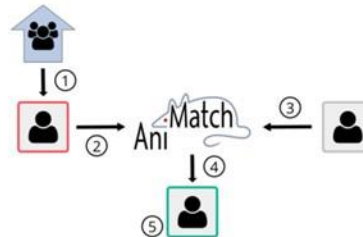
